NURSERY FEE SCHEDULE 2019/2020

The Nursery fee is the same as the Reception fee. We accept pupils entitled to FEEE provision. We are able to offer this over the 36 weeks of our school year.

Term 1 Weeks:	14
Term 2 Weeks:	11
Term 3 Weeks:	11

Children are entitled to 38 weeks of FEEE. You may secure another provider but Essex CC ask us to inform you that that ECC is under no obligation to offer the remainder of the child's FEEE at a different provider.

The annual school fee for Reception is £6,216. The hourly rate for non-funded hours is £5.75. In any one week a child is allowed 15 hours free.

We aim to offer FEEE provision within school hours: FEEE sessions are normally 3 hour morning only sessions (9.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.) and a 3 hour afternoon only session (12.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m.) where the pupils bring in lunch. We aim to be flexible within the constraint that any one session must be no shorter than 2.5 hours a day and its provision not affect the education of the others in the group.

Children in their reception year may start at 0845 and stay till 1535 but these hours are chargeable where FEEE is being claimed.

FEEE sessions will be detailed on per term invoices to be paid in advance before the first of the month either monthly or termly. Normal terms and conditions apply for taking up a place at the school.

All children become eligible in the term after they turn three, see table below A child born in the period	Will become eligible for a free place
1 April to 31 August	1 September following a child's third birthday
1 September to 31 December	1 January following a child's third birthday
1 January to 31 March	1 April following a child's third birthday

Parents will need to provide a copy of the child's birth certificate.
